Emblems and Awards for T&T Clubbers and Leaders

Note: Unless otherwise indicated, we will describe all emblem placement as if you are wearing the shirt (i.e., left sleeve = left sleeve as if you are wearing the shirt).

Book Award badges

T&T clubbers earn an award badge by completing Discovery 1 or Challenge 1 in a particular T&T handbook. The color of the badge corresponds to the color of the handbook cover: a red badge for Book One, a blue badge for Book Two, green for Book Three, and yellow for Book Four. Attach the badge to the clubber's uniform or T-Shirt. Clubbers should wear only one badge at a time. When a clubber earns the next badge, he or she should remove the previous badge and put the new one in its place.

If you use the casual uniform or T-Shirts, attach the badge onto the award strip on the upper right side. If you use the gray uniform, attach the badge onto the red emblem on the upper left side for boys, and on the upper right side for girls.

Achievement seals

Clubbers earn these seals as they complete each of the eight Discoveries or eight Challenges in a particular T&T handbook. One seal is awarded upon completion of each individual Discovery or Challenge. Attach these seals to the numbered circles on the award badge.

Silver and Gold seals

Clubbers earn these seals by completing the Silver and Gold extra-credit sections in a particular T&T handbook. The Silver seal is awarded when all 16 Silver sections in a handbook are finished; the Gold seal, when all 16 Gold sections in a handbook are finished. (There are two sections of each per Discovery or Challenge.) Attach the seals to the blank circles on the award badge.

Completion patches

Clubbers receive a completion patch when they complete a T&T handbook. Attach these patches just above the award badge on the clubber's uniform or T-Shirt, beginning, as you face the badge, with Book One's patch on the left, and then adding each subsequent patch, as clubbers earn them, to make an arch from left to right over the award badge.

Other T&T emblems:

- Church registration numbers (not an award)
Sew these directly under and touching the "Awana clubs" emblem on the right sleeve of the gray uniform. (Clubbers can also wear these numbers on the right sleeve of the casual or T-Shirt uniform options.)
- Adopt-a-Club emblems
Clubbers receive these emblems for supporting the church's or club's Adopt-a-Club. Clubbers should wear these emblems on their uniform or T-Shirt sleeves, beginning on the left sleeve, and continuing on the right as they need more space. These emblems are designed to be "stacked" one on top of the other as they are earned, so keep this in mind if the clubber plans to support the Adopt-a-Club for more than one year; if one sleeve already has several emblems displayed on it, begin on the next sleeve so all the AAC emblems can eventually be worn together.
 - Year 1- red emblem
 - Year 2- blue emblem
 - Year 3- green emblem
 - Year 4- yellow emblem
- AwanaGames® awards
Clubbers can earn emblems, trophies, pins and ribbons for participation in AwanaGames® (formerly Olympics). Clubbers should wear emblems on their uniform or T-Shirt sleeves, beginning on the left sleeve, and continuing on the right as they need more space. They should wear pins on their collar.
- Grand Prix Participation pin
Clubbers can receive this pin if they participate in the Grand Prix. They should wear it on their collar or on the Grand Prix cap.
- Bible Quizzing awards (presented by the local missionaries)
Clubbers earn these awards by participating in Bible Quizzing. They should wear the emblem they

receive on their left sleeve. Red is for book one, blue is for book two, green, is for book three, and yellow is for book four.

For T&T Leadership

Pin placement —There are several options for displaying pins:

1. On the shirt or blouse collar
2. On the leader award lanyard

For Directors and Leaders:

- Leader Training award
Leaders earn this award by successfully completing of the LeaderReview (Basic Training Test). The award is a pin.
 - o Wear pin on lanyard or shirt collar
